A little information about the Centre:

The Centre is owned and run by the Lutheran Council of Great Britain, which represents 11 national Lutheran churches with congregations or chaplaincies in Britain. The Centre runs on a bed and breakfast basis which is in operation throughout the year. It has a laundry room; TV room; function room for social activities; Chapel; games room; student lounge; study room and computer room. Each floor has two showers, two toilets and a kitchen for sharing between 10 residents. We provide a duvet, pillow, bed linen and a towel. The kitchen on your floor is fully equipped with pots, pans, crockery, cutlery, toaster, kettle, microwave, oven, fridge and freezer. Each study bedroom has a telephone, which can be used for incoming, outgoing and internal calls. There is also a voicemail facility. Outgoing calls from these telephones have to be pre-paid at the Office. The ILSC is located just a few minutes walk from King's Cross, Russell Square and Euston underground stations. Locally there are plenty of amenities, all of which are only a few minutes walk away. These include supermarkets, dry cleaners, shoe repairers, hairdressers, doctors, dentists, bookshops, internet cafes, restaurants, pubs and cafes.
